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was also fun working out what those three-letter words stood for. In addition, it was fun finding out which was a debit card, and which was a credit card. I decided that I would use both.

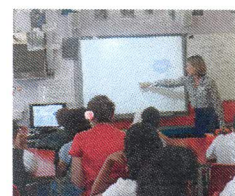
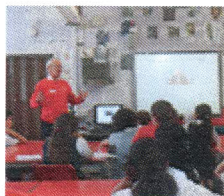

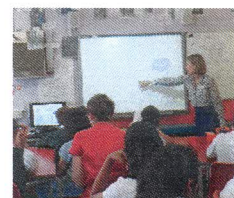
was an interesting experience as I soon learnt

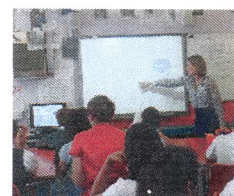
Dear Canopus Volunteers,
